

ROR in the Community – A 2010 Survey

Summary Report

In June 2010, the seven staff members at ROR Tax Professionals took an inventory of their community service work and experience.



The **five major findings** are reported below.

1. Cumulatively, the staff at ROR has been volunteering for a **total of 130 years**.
2. In an average month, ROR staff volunteer about 100 hrs total; **that's 1,200 hours a year!**
